President Davis Announces Strategic Planning Steering Committee

President Russell A. Davis recently appointed a steering committee of faculty and staff to lead a community-wide discussion focused on the future growth of the College.

“The strategic planning process is second in importance only to the Middle States Accreditation process,” said Davis. “The College cannot move forward without a plan, and that plan must be carefully considered, must contain full involvement and participation from the campus, our board and our external partners, and must reflect the direction that we agree to move toward giving full thought to how initiatives will be funded.”

Comprised of 16 members, the steering committee is charged with examining both the internal and external environment of the College, as well as taking into consideration actions and opportunities that would serve as institutional priorities during the next three years. The committee will study all areas in relation to GCC’s core mission and identify areas most important to the College’s success.

Throughout the strategic-planning process, everyone at GCC will be encouraged to share their ideas. Input from external constituents will also be invited and considered. Initial recommendations will be provided to the president in May with the final strategic plan results completed sometime near the end of June.
