Title SOUNDS OF THE RENAISSANCE COME TO GCC

Deptford Twp.—Fans of Renaissance and Baroque Europe music won't want to miss **The Baltimore Consort** when the group comes to the Gloucester County College campus on **Friday, January 27, at 7:30 p.m. in the Fine Arts Center.**

A virtuoso ensemble, The Baltimore Consort specializes in the courtly and popular music of the 16th to 18th centuries, as well as traditional music rooted in earlier times. Their variety of instruments—lute, viol, flute, cittern, early guitar, rebec, recorder, crumhorn, and bandora—and their lively performances—have delighted audiences on both sides of the Atlantic and earned them recognition as Top Classical Crossover Artist (Billboard Magazine, 1993).

Founded in 1980, the group has toured widely in the US and abroad, appearing in concert halls, schools and festivals, as well as on syndicated radio broadcasts.
