Title NJSTARS INFORMATION SESSION
AT GCC ON WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 11

Deptford Twp. - The NJ STARS Scholarship provides Gloucester County students who finish in the top 20 percent of their high school graduating class with FREE tuition and fees at Gloucester County College (GCC).

NJ STARS who are graduating in June 2006 and their parents are invited to attend an informational session on **Wednesday, January 11, at 6 p.m.** in the College's Health Sciences Building **Room 500** to learn the details about this unique educational opportunity.

The free scholarship program, which started September 2004, covers up to five semesters of tuition and approved fees at local community colleges. NJ STAR students must take at least 12 and no more than 15 college-level credits each semester and be enrolled in an associate degree program. Students have up to two years after graduating from high school to enroll at a New Jersey community college.

Gloucester County College offers a wide variety of academic programs under an open admission policy, made even stronger through NJSTARS. Its selective admission programs include Nursing, Diagnostic Medical Sonography and Nuclear Medicine Technology.
