Deptford Twp. – Gloucester County College is offering [free literacy instruction](#) through its ESL (English as a Second Language) Plus program to help South Jersey individuals develop language skills. Both day and evening classes are available.

All participants must provide a social security number at the time of registration. Classes are now forming for locations in Woodbury, Glassboro, and Williamstown.

Through a grant awarded by the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development, GCC is helping individuals and others with limited English proficiency develop the skills and knowledge necessary to become active and informed parents, workers, and community members.

Gloucester County College's ESL Plus program provides adult students with personalized assistance in reading, writing, and speaking English more proficiently in addition to instruction on citizenship, naturalization procedures, civic participation, and U.S. history and government.
