### FAMED SECOND CITY IMPROV GROUP TO PERFORM AT GCC ON THURSDAY, MARCH 5

Deptford Twp - The Second City, an internationally recognized sketch and improv comedy troupe, will perform at Gloucester County College at 7 p.m. Thursday, March 5, in the GCC Fine Arts Center.

This is a return visit by the group, which appears regularly on TV. This year's performance will feature some of the best sketches, songs and improvisations from Second City's 45 plus year history. Tickets are \$8 per person in advance, \$10 at the door. The Fine Arts Center seats only 220, so Student Activities Coordinator Cheryl Budd suggests early reservations. Budd also noted that there will be no admission after the show starts.

Second City was founded in Chicago in 1959, and has become the premier training ground for the comedy worlds best and brightest. An impressive alumni list of comedians such as Dan Aykroyd, Julia Louis-Dreyfus, John Belushi, Gilda Radner, John Candy and Mike Myers all got their start at Second City.

Audience members will have the opportunity to see comedy stars in the making while performing satire and cutting-edge improvisation. The comedy troupe will perform two 40-minute acts with an intermission.

Second City's appearance is part of an academic year-long cultural and entertainment program offered by GCC Student Activities. The College has more than 6,100 students enrolled in academic programs.
