TASTEFUL EVENT TO SUPPORT GCC FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

Deptford Twp. – Gloucester County College’s Wine & Chocolate Festival on Friday, October 2, will make sipping and sampling a tasteful way to support student scholarships.

The Gloucester County College Foundation will host the third-annual event in the Dr. Ross Beitzel Art Gallery located in the College Center Mezzanine from 6 to 9 p.m. Five chocolate shops and 12 wine companies, including four from South Jersey—Bellview Winery in Landisville, Cedarvale Winery & Vineyard in Logan Township, Heritage Vineyards of Richwood and Wagonhouse Winery in Mullica Hill—will offer guests an assortment of sweets and spirits to taste test. The festival is being hosted by Joe Canal’s Route 45 in West Deptford and will also include Crescent Moon Coffee & Tea in Mullica Hill, A Taste of Philly Soft Pretzel in Woodbury, hors d’oeuvres and music.
