GCC EXTENDS SPRING REGISTRATION PAYMENT DEADLINE

Deptford Twp. – To help relieve some of the stress this holiday season and offer community neighbors a reprieve during these challenging economic times, Gloucester County College has extended the spring registration payment deadline. Students will now have the option to pay for classes on their original payment schedule or by the new later due dates on January 8 (in person by 4:30 p.m.) and online through January 10.

“GCC is in the business of education and ensuring student success. It’s important with the way the economy is today that we strive to be a good neighbor and assist students when we can,” said President Russell A. Davis. “We want to lessen the possibility of students getting dropped from classes that have been scheduled around work and other daily necessities.”

With today’s unsettled economic times, GCC continues to be one of the best values in education offering the lowest tuition rate in the state at \$83 per credit hour. The College’s transfer program allows students seeking bachelor’s degrees to save thousands of dollars the first two years then go on to four-year universities without losing credits.
