EARN A DEGREE ON THE WEEKEND AT GCC

Deptford Twp. – Beginning in September, Gloucester County College will offer students more scheduling alternatives when it comes to earning a degree. The College's new weekend option will make it possible for working professionals and individuals with busy schedules to attend the classes necessary to obtain an Associate in Arts or Sciences degree.

Weekend scholars will now be able to take advantage of extended course offerings on Friday evenings and during the day on Saturday and Sunday. On campus instruction and hybrid courses, which are taught both in the classroom and online, in addition to GCC's regular online offerings, provide students with flexible and convenient choices when pursuing higher education.

The Associate in Arts (A.A.) and the Associate in Science (A.S.) degrees usually require 60 to 66 semester hours of credit and are similar to the first two years of academic work at a four-year institution, only more affordable. Course credits are transferable for students choosing to pursue baccalaureate degrees at colleges and universities.
