Roadrunners Win Second Straight Over Bergen CC

The men's basketball team improved to 6-9 with an impressive 69-52 win over visiting Bergen CC from Paramus, NJ. The Roadrunners are a solid 5-3 now in NJCAA Region XIX play. Sophomore Kevin Booth (Williamstown HS) led GCC in scoring with 21 points. Lerone Lashley 13, Robert Anders 12, and Ian Still 11, contributed double digit scoring to help the Roadrunners. GCC led 38-29 at halftime. This was the second game in as many nights for the Roadrunners as they picked up a 73-67 road win on Tuesday at Atlantic Cape CC.

GCC Sophomore Kevin Booth has played his best basketball in this stretch of back to back wins for the Roadrunners. Booth scored 20 points on Tuesday night in the teams 73-67 win at Atlantic Cape CC and followed that up with 21 tonight against Bergen CC. In both games Booth was aggressive in the first half and set the tone for the team by taking the ball to the basket. In both games Booth got to the foul line four times in the first half and scored ten points in each first half. Freshman Larone Lashley, a late addition to the team who also plans to play for the baseball team in the spring, scored 13 points in each of the wins. Lashley has shown a streaky touch from the three point line this season and was able to get to the basket for a key score late in the game against Bergen.
