ROADRUNNERS PICK UP WIN HEADING TO REGION TOURNAMENT

February 15, 2011 Deptford, NJ

The men's basketball team scored a much needed home win over Camden CC on Tuesday night after dropping their previous two contests. The win pushed the GCC overall record to 13-12 and improved their Region 19 record to 13-8. Sophomore Isiah Dixon steadied the team by scoring a 16 points and providing toughness under the basket against a Camden team that had a big size advantage under the basket.

The team opened a lead in the latter parts of the second half and took a 39-22 lead at halftime after freshman Randolph Summiel hit a short corner jumper at the buzzer. Summiel finished the game with a season-high 11 points and provided a nice spark for the team coming off the bench. Fred Battee found his range in the second half scoring 11 of his 15 points in that half of the game including a clutch three point shot when Camden had cut the lead to single digits. The Roadrunners only made 11 of 20 foul shots in the second half and will need to improve on that but finished with a 74-60 win.

The team will now play on Thursday at home at 7pm against Atlantic CC in their regular season finale before the Region 19 Tournament seedings take place on Friday. The first round of the region tournament will take place on Monday. The Roadrunners are likely to be the #5 or #6 seed in the tournament and if that is the case will play on the road Monday night.
