## **Dan Calhoun Resigns as GCC Wrestling Coach** *May 5, 2011, Deptford, NJ*

Head Wrestling Coach Dan Calhoun has stepped down from his post at Gloucester County College citing personal reasons including a recent move to the shore area from his Washington Township residence. Calhoun served as Head Coach of the program for four seasons. He brought with him a wealth of wrestling knowledge and experience that served him well at GCC. Calhoun won three Garden State Athletic Conference Championships at GCC and in the 2009-10 season led the team to a third place finish at the NJCAA National Wrestling Championship. This past season the Roadrunners went 6-2 and Justin Pencook went on to earn All-American status with his third place finish at the NJCAA National Championships.

Calhoun was a standout wrestler at GCC, earning All-American status as both a freshman and sophomore, before continuing his career at the University of North Carolina where he qualified for the 1999 NCAA Championships. Calhoun will continue to teach at Williamstown HS.

The Gloucester CC Wrestling Program has a rich history and the search for a new head coach will begin immediately.
