Norcia Chosen to Lead Roadrunners Women's Soccer Program

The Gloucester County College Board of Trustees recently named Megan Norcia as the new women's soccer coach.

Norcia, of Smithville, Galloway Township, comes from The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey where she served for three seasons as assistant coach. Before her stint at Stockton, Norcia coached at the high school level at Wall Township High School in Monmouth County and Winslow Township High School in Camden County.

In addition to her coaching skills, Norcia also brings to GCC experience as a player who excelled at both the high school and collegiate levels. She was a three-time All-New Jersey Athletic Conference player at Stockton and has played for the South Jersey Banshees and for Real Shore FC of the WPSL.

“Megan’s job will be to re-energize the program and take it to new heights,” said GCC Athletic Director and Dean of Health, Physical Education and Recreation Ron Case. “She was an important member of the coaching staff at Stockton where she worked with mid-fielders. Megan’s ability to recruit at local high schools also played an important part in the decision to hire her at GCC.”

“I’m extremely excited,” said Norcia. “The College and the athletic department have a great reputation. I’m thrilled to be a part of that now.”

Norcia replaces former Roadrunners soccer coach Dan Roberts who stepped down last November after his twelfth season at GCC. Roberts compiled a 95-88-10 record over 12 seasons including two National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Region XIX championships and a trip to the NJCAA National Championship game in 2007.
