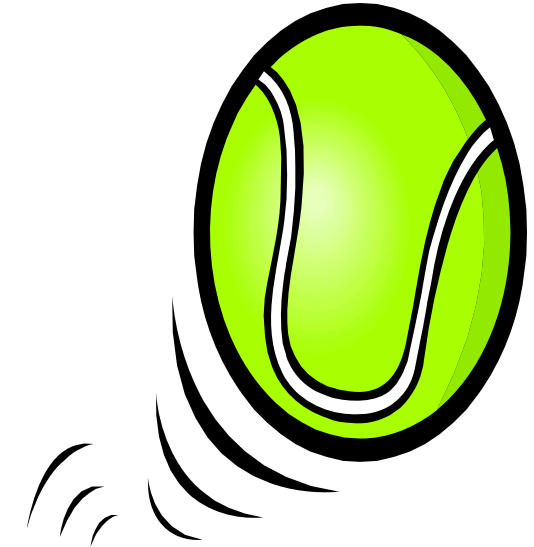

CAMP COACHING STAFF

BRIAN ROWAN, Head Men's Tennis Coach at GCC. The GCC Men's team has become a regional power under Brian's leadership, including a Regional Championship and two 4th place finishes at the Junior College National Championships. Brian is a PTR Certified Tennis Professional as well as a former #1 tennis player at Gateway H.S. and Gloucester Co. Times Tournament Doubles Champion in 1992 and Singles Runner-Up in 1994.

Skills, Drills and Competition Camp

August 3th – 6th (Rain Date Aug. 7)

The camp for boys and girls is designed to develop all tennis skills – serve, forehand, backhand, volley and overhead. Special emphasis will be placed on footwork and tennis strategy.

*This camp is designed for beginners to intermediate players who need skill improvement and training in the fundamentals. On the first day of camp coaches will evaluate players and place them in the appropriate level.

Championship Competition Camp

August 10th–13th (Rain Date Aug. 14)

Boys 1-4PM / Girls 5-8PM

The camp is designed for VARSITY PLAYERS OR USTA RANKED PLAYERS ONLY. We will provide high level competitive drills and individual match play. This camp will be 3 hours of intense footwork training combined with tennis skills. Please be in shape and ready to work. This camp will give players the opportunity to measure themselves against other players in SJ.
