Women's Tennis Improves to 3-0

The GCC women's tennis team improved to 3-0 on the season with a tough 5-4 win on the road at Brookdale CC in Monmouth County. The Roadrunners captured two of the three doubles matches but needed freshman Amanda Chandler (West Deptford, NJ/West Deptford HS) to pull out her win at sixth singles to ensure the win. Chandler defeated Olga Kanavskaya 6-3, 6-1. While GCC remained unbeaten, the Jersey Blues fell to 1-1 on the season.
