Tournament Recap:

The Roadrunners made a late charge on Sunday afternoon but fell just two points short of sharing the Region XIX Championship with Brookdale CC. The Roadrunners trailed by two point after Day 1 of play but won three of their four singles matches on Sunday to close to within one point. If the Roadrunners won both of their doubles matches they would have done no worse than a tie and could have won. Third doubles team Kirsten Bushcer and Joanna O'Donnell pulled out their win and Brookdale won at first doubles so the tournament came down to the second doubles match between Gloucester and Brookdale. It turned out to be the match of the tournament but Brookdale pulled out a 5-7, 6-4, 7-5 win to seal the championship.
