Women's Tennis Improves to 2-0

The women's tennis team improved to 2-0 on the season with an impressive shutout win over host Mercer CC. The win sets up a battle of unbeaten teams on Thursday at GCC as the Roadrunners will host unbeaten Brookdale CC. The winner of that match will take the early lead in NJCAA Region XIX.

In Monday's match, the Roadrunners overwhelmed Mercer with steady play from top to bottom. Third doubles tandem Kirsten Buscher and Joanna O'Donnell scored the first point of the day with an 8-1 win. That match set the tone for the day and the rest of the doubles matches fell in line to set up a 3-0 lead heading into the singles matches.

The most competitive singles match came at #1 singles as sophomore Justine Stahl got her first win of the year in a 4-6, 7-6, 10-7 thriller. Stahl, a former national semifinalist at #2 singles, did not play last season but decided to return to the Roadrunner lineup this season and has provided plenty of leadership.
