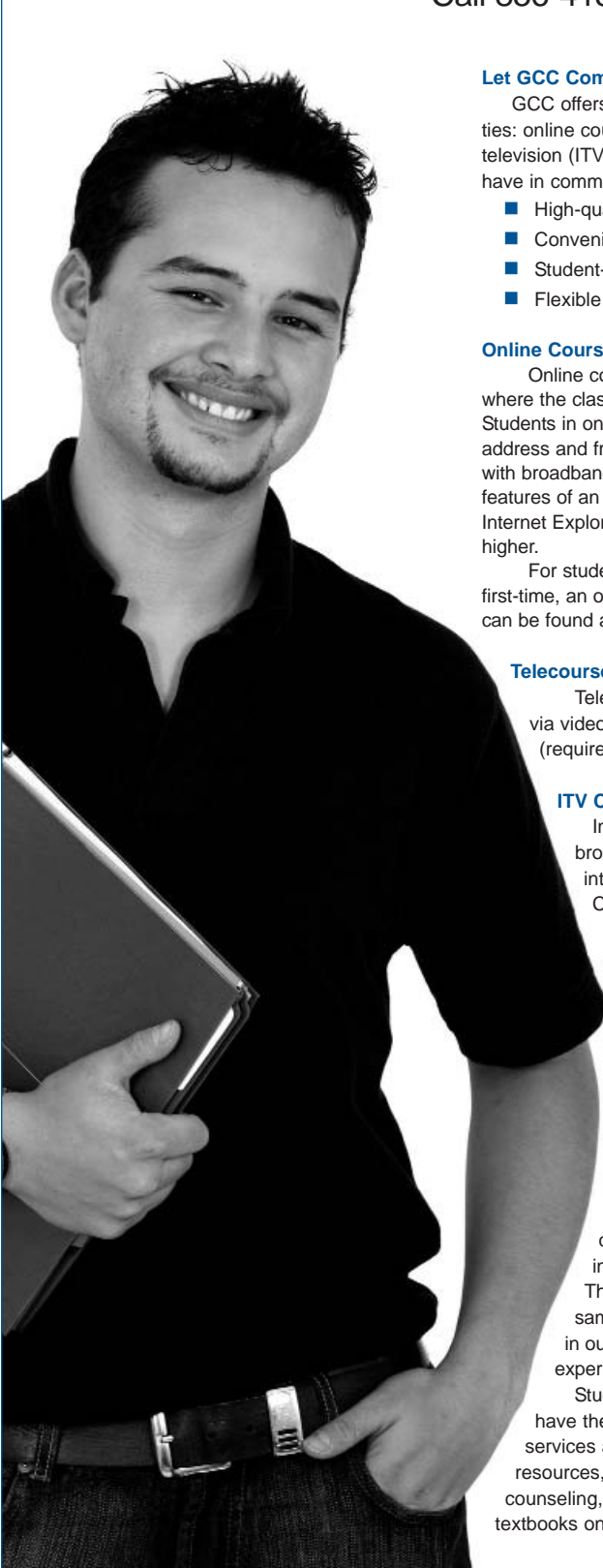

Let GCC Come to You

GCC offers three types of eLearning opportunities: online courses, telecourses and interactive television (ITV) courses. What do the courses have in common? Students find them to be:

- High-quality
- Convenient
- Student-friendly

Online Courses

Online courses are Internet-based courses where the classroom is the course web site. Students in online courses must have an e-mail address and frequent, easy access to a computer with broadband Internet access. To access the features of an online course, students must use Internet Explorer 7.0 or higher or FireFox 3.0 or higher.

For students taking online courses for the first-time, an online orientation is mandatory. It can be found at <http://elearning.gccnj.edu>.

Telecourses

Telecourses are presented visually via video cassette, DVD or streaming video (requires a computer).

ITV Courses

Interactive television courses are broadcast from the GCC campus to interactive sites within Gloucester County.

Keeping in Touch

Students in eLearning courses maintain regular contact with their instructors. Guidance is never more than an e-mail or phone call away.

eLearning courses are part of GCC's regular course offerings and are fully equivalent to courses taught on campus. Courses may be applied to a GCC degree or certificate, taken as electives, or for general interest or professional development. The faculty for these courses are the same professional experts you meet in our classrooms, and the learning experience is equally rewarding.

Students enrolled in eLearning courses have the full-range of student and academic services available to them including library resources, academic advising, tutoring, testing, counseling, and the convenience of purchasing textbooks online!
