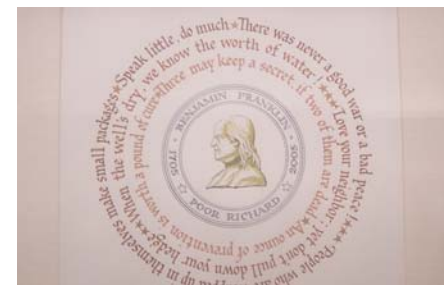
Travel Around the World in 90 Minutes
